Description View of Lucy Compton Street Cheney in a living room or parlor, holding her infant son, George Wells Cheney. Lucy is sitting in a chair in the

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middle of the room and George is upright in her lap. She is wearing a dark dress and he is wearing a long white one. There is a piece of cloth hanging on the back of their chair. There is another chair just behind them to the left, and a wicker chair in the background on the right. There is an open doorway directly behind them. A vase of flowers is sitting on a table to the left of the doorway, and photographs hang on the wall to the right. The photograph is circular, printed on a sheet, and mounted on cardstock. The edges of the cardstock are gilt. The back of the mount is covered in paper that has fine stripes and a floral pattern printed on it.
