## Title Narrows Island from West Quarry

Date 1917

Medium Photography; nitrate negatives

Description Black and white photographic negative, view of Narrows Island, Guilford, Connecticut from top of John Beattie Granite's West Quarry. Piles or outcroppings of stone and vegetation surround a small wooden building at center with a dilapidated frame building at far left. A thick wire runs from the far left to the center. Steel rail tracks are visible in the foreground with a view of the Connecticut coastline in the background. The photographed area was formerly the hub of Beattie Quarries, containing the office, sail loft, blacksmith shop, water supply tanks, and steam powerhouse.
