Title Crew of Schooner AMERICAN EAGLE

Date 1917

Description Black and white photographic negative group portrait of the crew of John Beattie Granite's schooner, the AMERICAN EAGLE, in Spring of 1917. The group pose on the deck of the wooden schooner. The six men have been identified as [Left-Right] Wilson Lee, Henry Hendricksen, "Paddy" Begley (or Bagley), stonemaker Tom Hannigan, stonemaker "Gus" Tonelli, and Patrick O'Keefe are seated; one man, "Grassy" Patrick Ducey stands behind the seated group. The men are all dressed in work clothes. The schooner is loaded with granite for the entrance wall of the Smith Estate in Stamford, Connecticut. The photograph was taken by Nan Cook, a former deepwater sailor.
