They are both dressed in dark colored floor-length skirts and white shirtwaists with dark ties at the neck. The woman on the left wears a straw hat with a veil on the brim, she is posed with her left hand on her hip, in her right hand she holds a white handkerchief or other material. The women migrated from Union County, Virginia.
