## **Title Galamanders on Leetes Island**

Description Black and white photographic negative, view of a galamander at the Leetes Island Quarry used to move stone used for base of the Statue of Liberty.

The galamander, a wagon-like conveyance with two spoked wooden wheels attached to a frame consisting of a single large wooden beam, sits in a grassy area with a rocky area in the background.
