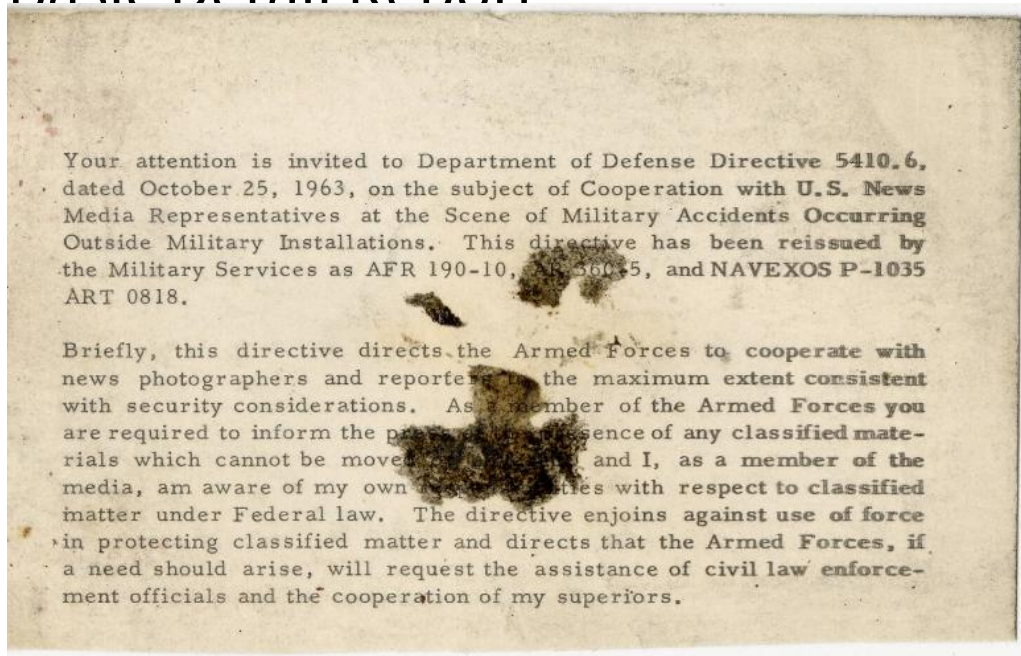

Armed Forces you / are required to inform the press of the presence of any
classified mate- / rials which cannot be moved [illegible] and I, as a member of
the / media, am aware of my own [illegible] with respect to classified / matter
under Federal law. The directive enjoins against use of force / in protecting
classified matter and directs that the Armed Forces, if / a need should arise, will
request the assistance of civil law enforce- / ment officials and the cooperation
of my superiors." Printed in black ink on back: "It is hoped that this card will
assist you in covering off / base military aircraft accidents consistent with
