## Title A Team of Horses Clearing Snow

Date 1900 - 1925

Medium Photomechanical print: ink on postcard

Description View of a team of five or six horses pulling a large rolling cylinder down a snowy street. There is a man seated at the front of the apparatus, steering the horses, and another man sitting at the back. The machine is either clearing or compacting the snow. There are piles of snow on the side of the street, which is lined with houses.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width):  $3 \frac{1}{8} \times 5 \frac{3}{16}$  in. ( $7.9 \times 13.2$  cm) Sheet (height x width):  $3 \frac{7}{16} \times 5 \frac{7}{16}$  in. ( $8.7 \times 13.8$  cm)
