Medium Daguerreotype; silver-plated copper plate in brass mat package in leather-covered wooden case; red velvet pad in left side of open case

Description Sixth plate daguerreotype of Eleanor Mills Bissell (married to Thomas Bissell) by an unknown photographer. Bissell is pictured in older age, in a three-quarter profile view. She is wearing a ruffled white daycap (or bonnet,

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but probably a daycap) that is tied under her chin. Her dress appears to have

buttons down the front. It has a relatively deep v-neck and wide sleeves. In

addition to the fabric from the daycap, she is also wearing a chemisette or

kerchief or a similar garment that covers her chest.

Dimensions Plate (height x width): $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. (8.3×7 cm) Other (case

height x width x depth): $3 \frac{3}{4} \times 3 \frac{1}{4} \times \frac{5}{8}$ in. ($9.5 \times 8.3 \times 1.6$ cm)
