Description Ninth plate ambrotype of Edith Maria Bromley as a little girl of

perhaps three to five years of age. She is sitting in a chair with turned elements

visible behind her on the left. Edith is wearing a dress with a wide neckline, a

pleated bodice, and puffed sleeves. Her hands are folded in her lap. Her

shoulder-length hair is worn in ringlets.
