

# Basic Detail Report



**Title** Charlotte Alice Barnard

**Date** 1855-1863

**Primary Maker** Unknown

**Medium** Tintype; collodion on iron sheet in brass window mat package in tooled leather-covered wooden case

**Description** Ninth plate tintype of Charlotte Alice Barnard (later Mrs. Louis Filley), taken sometime in adolescence. She has short brown hair parted in the

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middle. She is wearing a striped dress with a wide, low neckline. It has short, wide sleeves trimmed with ribbon and a short waist. She is wearing a brooch (perhaps a cameo) pinned to the center of the bodice neckline, and a thin necklace.

Dimensions Plate (height x width):  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2$ in. ( $6.4 \times 5.1$ cm) Other (height x width x depth):  $2\frac{7}{8} \times 2\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{5}{8}$ in. ( $7.3 \times 6.4 \times 1.6$ cm)
