Basic Detail Report

Description Quarter plate daguerreotype of Leverett Brainard, likely made in the mid-1850s, when Brainard was in his mid-20s. He is wearing a jacket, waistcoat, white shirt with a standing collar, and a tie that appears to be silk. His hair is fashioned into the distinctive mid-1850s men's style, with a puff of hair at the center of the forehead. His facial hair is worn in a fringe around his cheeks and chin, with a mustache with turned up ends and a small beard under his lower lip. Dimensions Plate (height x width): $4\,1/4\times3\,1/4$ in. $(10.8\times8.3$ cm) Other (height x width x depth): $4\,5/8\times3\,5/8\times5/8$ in. $(11.7\times9.2\times1.6$ cm)
