

## **Title Woman's Shoes**

Date about 1760-1770

Primary Maker Jonathan Hose & Son

Medium Hand-stitched silk satin, linen, leather, and wood

Description White silk satin shoes with an oval toe, Louis heel, and latchets which cross the vamp and would have been held by a buckle. The tongue is wide and square, with a slight dip in the center. The continuous leather sole covers the front of the heel. The heel is also covered with the white satin. The silk is lined with plain-woven linen and bound with white silk tape. There is no rand. The shoes are straight, not right and left. The vamp has been split and whipstitched to finish the raw edges in order to make the shoe a bit wider across the instep.
