

## Title Woman's Overshoe

Date about 1830-1855

Primary Maker Hayward Rubber Company

Medium Rubber, lined with hand-stitched leather, wool and cotton, and bound with silk tape

Description Woman's overshoe, made of dark rubber and lined in the heel area with leather and in the forepart with a napped fabric (probably cotton with wool). The vamp is slit and turned back. The throatline and slit are bound with black silk tape. The overshoe has a rounded toe. The sock lining is a layer of leather overlaid with plain-woven white cotton. There is no separate sole. Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width x length):  $2.5/8 \times 2.7/8 \times 8.7/8$  in.  $(6.7 \times 7.3 \times 22.5 \text{cm})$
