

**Title Miniature Boots**

Medium Molded rubber with machine-knitted cotton lining glued inside

## **Basic Detail Report**

Description Black rubber miniature boots, designed with the leg higher in the front than the back, a round toe, and knock-on type of heel. The boots have a loop "bootstrap" molded on either side of the top. The leg is molded with a vertical ribbed moire pattern, while the vamp, which extends up the front and back of the ankle, is smooth. Molded across the front of the leg, near the top, is: "CANDEE". The boots are molded with details imitating seams and tacks on the heel. The sole is molded with a tread pattern of a diamond grid. The boots are lined with tan knitted cotton fabric.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width x depth):  $5 \times 1 \times 1/8 \times 3 \times 3/8$  in. (12.7 x 2.9 x 8.6cm)
