These include an all-seeing eye, an open Bible, an equilateral triangle, a winged cherub, a dove with an olive branch, three columns, a flaming torch, a lamb, a sleeping child and a sleeping lion, a beehive, a serpent, a bundle of sticks or fasces, a hatchet and a chain, a cauldron and clasped hands. Some symbols are surrounded by decorative cartouches.
