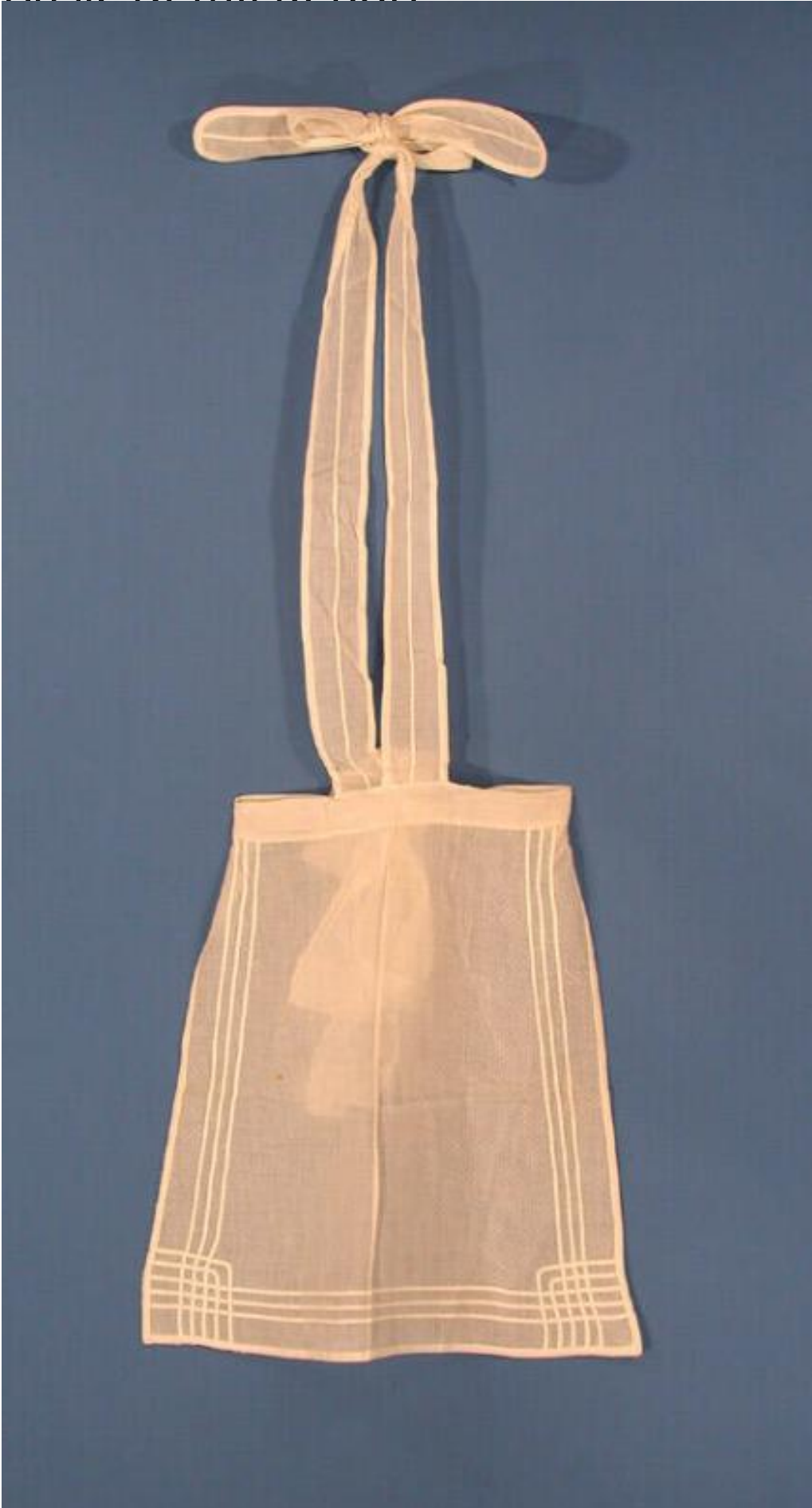

Title Maid's Uniform Apron

Date about 1920s-1950s

Primary Maker Tolles family

Medium Machine-stitched cotton

Description Maid's apron of sheer white cotton with small white polka dots, embellished with rows of applied narrow bias strips that intersect at the corners, creating a grid pattern. The apron has shoulder straps that meet in a V at the center front waistband; they would have pinned in the back. The 2 3/4-inch-wide apron strings are pleated into the 1 1/2-inch-wide waistband.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (length, excluding straps x width across bottom): 17 3/4 x 18in. (45.1 x 45.7cm)
