

# Basic Detail Report

**Title** Y.W.C.A., Pearl Street, Hartford

**Date** 1892-1898

**Primary Maker** Unknown

**Medium** Photography; gelatin silver print on paper

**Description** A brick building with a mansard roof occupies a city lot. The building has pedimented windows on the top floor, brackets beneath the cornice, louvered shuttered, and metal fire escapes and railings. A broken pediment crowns the central bay above the front door. The porch has Corinthian columns and a striped awning. A sign reads: "WOMEN'S CHRISTIAN ASSOCIATION." Ivy grows on the walls. A low wire fence surrounds the grassy lawn. A shrub grows at the far right. A paved sidewalk is in the foreground, and a paved walkway is to the right of the building.
