Medium Hand-stitched cotton and linen, with cotton-covered bone buttons

Description Man's vest, possibly part of a uniform, made of white, twill-woven

cotton. The vest has a standing 2 1/2-inch deep collar and nine self-covered

buttons at the center front opening. There is a 5 3/4-inch-wide pocket on each

side. The backing of the vest is plain linen. It is also lined with plain linen. The

Basic Detail Report back of the vest is slightly gathered into the neckline. Four linen tapes sewn to

the back tie to adjust the fit.
