Description Plans for the basement and first floor of St. Peter's School, 160 Main Street, Hartford, include classrooms, coatrooms, stairs, exits, toilets, a kitchen, a locker room, storage rooms, and rooms for Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts. The plan for the layout of carnival booths on the school plaza includes booths, bingo tables, a fence, a flagpole, an elm tree, a driveway, and sidewalks, and indicates the locations of the church and school.
