Description Woman's petticoat of plain white cotton. It is smoothly fitted into

the 3/4-inch-wide waistband across the front and over the hips, and closely

gathered at the center back. A 14 1/2-inch-deep flounce edged with a whitework-

embroidered ruffle is stitched around and over the lower portion of the

petticoat, creating a double layer. The ruffle of the flounce is headed by seven

rows of narrow tucks. The center back opening extends 12 1/4 inches and

fastens with a single mother of pearl button on the waistband.
