Title Blouse, Skirt, and Belt Set

Date about 1945-1950

Medium Blouse (.a): Machine-stitched synthetic fiber (probably rayon), with metal and glass buttons, metal snap Skirt (.b): Machine-stitched synthetic fiber, metal zipper, hook and eye Belt (.c): Machine-stitched synthetic fiber, vinyl and metal buckle

Description Woman's three-piece dress of black crepe, consisting of a blouse, skirt and belt. The blouse fastens at center front with buttons set with rhinestones.

Dimensions Component (Blouse center back length x width across shoulders):

22 1/2 x 15 1/2in. (57.2 x 39.4cm) Component (Skirt length x waist diameter): 30 1

/2 x 29in. (77.5 x 73.7cm) Other (Skirt hem diameter): 52 1/2in. (133.4cm)

Component (Belt length x width of buckle): 37 1/2 x 1 1/4in. (95.3 x 3.2cm)
