## Title Woman's Shoes and Original Box

Date about 1957-1965

Primary Maker Hazel E. Tryon

Medium Machine-stitched leather

Description Red leather pumps with a three-inch-high covered heel and black side edging. The toe of the shoe is decorated with seven tear-drop shaped cut outs forming a triangular shape with a red leather bow at the base across the throat of the shoe. The bow is also decorated with two tear-drop shaped, padded figures. The interior of each shoe is lined with a beige leather along the sides and a deep red bottom stamped with gold. Decorative stitching is run along the top edge of each shoe.
