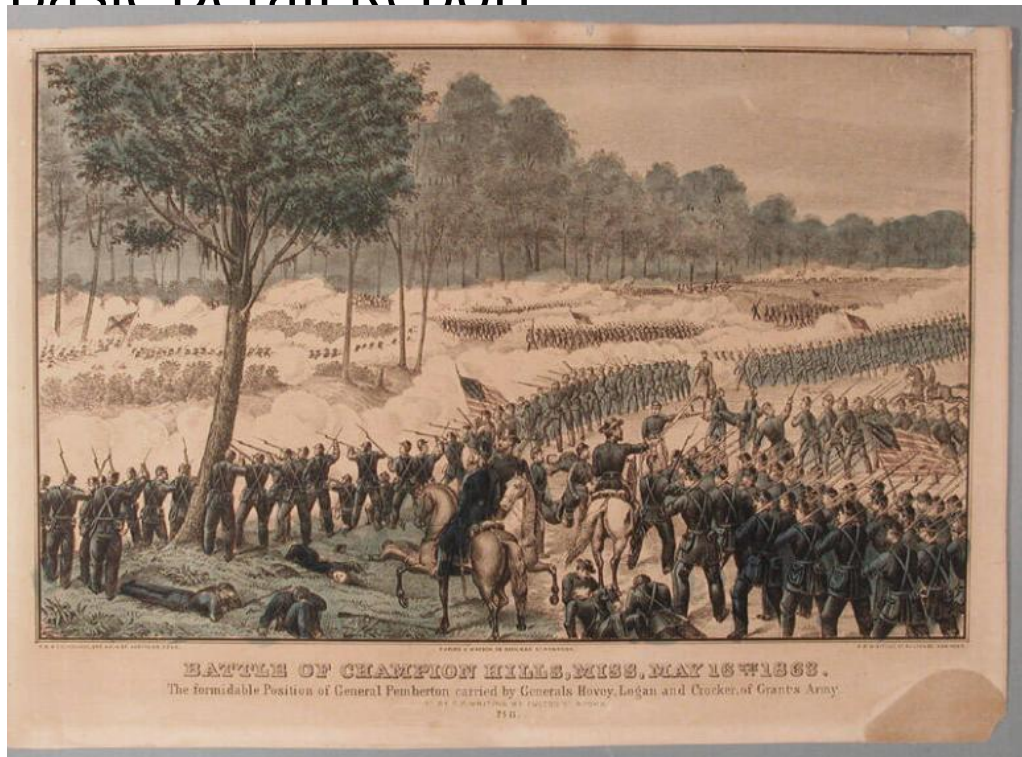


Basic Detail Report



Title Battle of Champion Hills, Miss, May 16th. 1863.
