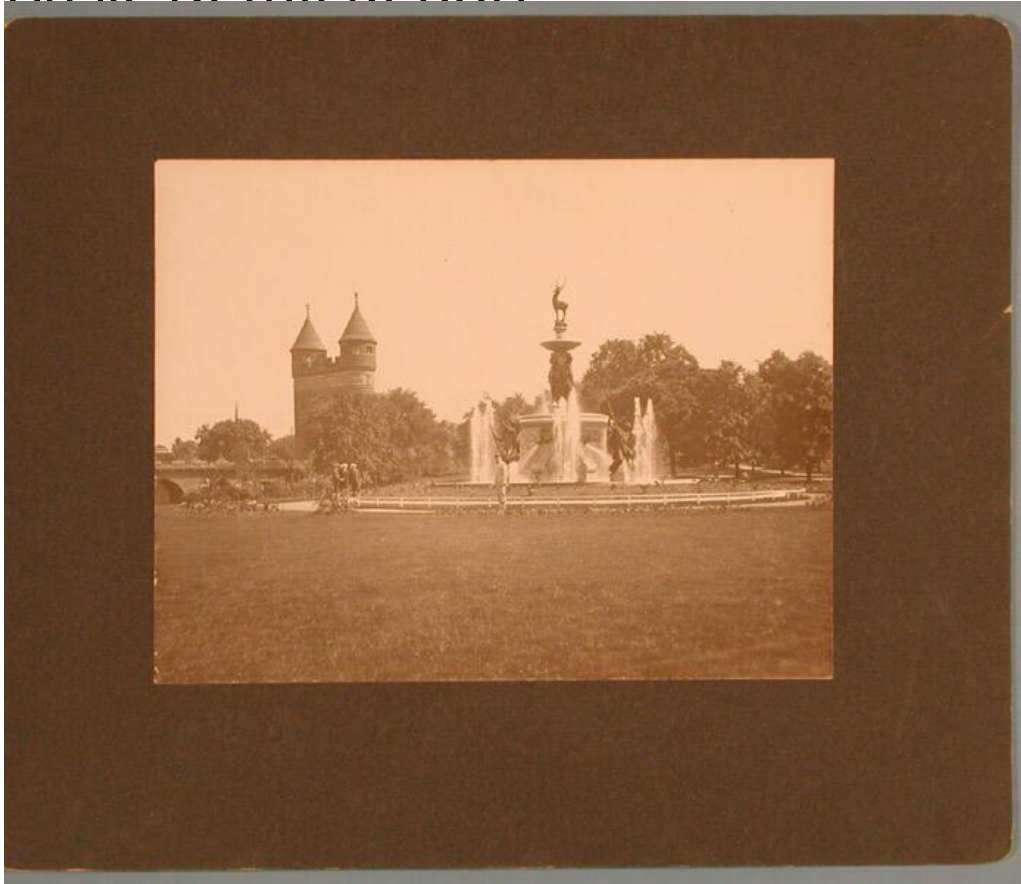

Description Several views of Bushnell Park in Hartford, Connecticut. There are several open grassy lawns, with trees and bushes, and a river running alongside.

A large Gothic domed structure, the Connecticut State Capitol, can be seen, as well as a Gothic brownstone archway, the Soldiers and Sailors Memorial Arch, and a bridge over the Park River.
