**Title** An American Shrine: Home of Dr. Helen Keller, Easton,

**Description** A two-story frame house is surrounded by a high stone retaining wall. Windows have louvered shutters. There is a lunette in the gable at the left. The front door has a porch with a pediment. A one-story wing at the left has dormer windows and a pergola. Stone steps lead up between two urns, apparently with plants growing in them. Two small trees are in front of the house. Birds are in the sky.
