## Title Presidents of the United States.

Description Ten bust-length oval portraits of men are arranged in two rows.

Each man wears a coat, vest, shirt, and necktie. Some men wear wigs. Drapery with tassels appears in the background of each portrait. Inscriptions beneath each portrait read: "GEORGE WASHINGTON. / Inaugurated March 4, 1789. - JOHN ADAMS. / Inaugurated March 4, 1797. - THOMAS JEFFERSON. / Inaugurated March 4, 1801. - JAMES MADISON. / Inaugurated March 4, 1809. - JAMES MONROE. / Inaugurated March 4, 1817. / JOHN QUINCY ADAMS. / Inaugurated March 4, 1825. - ANDREW JACKSON. / Inaugurated March 4, 1829. - MARTIN VAN BUREN. / Inaugurated March 4, 1837. - WM.
