**PERRY'S VICTORY ON LAKE ERIE.**

THE BATTLE OF LAKE ERIE, SEPTEMBER 19, 1813.

This plate represents the meeting of the two fleets at the moment when the *WARRIOR* is passing through the smoke of the *Lawrence*, having in short time before fallen the *Lawrence* in a small boat, under a temporary fire from the British *Agincourt* and *St. Lawrence*, the flag on board the *WARRIOR*.

Description Seven large warships are engaged in naval combat in the middle distance. Smoke and flames issue from the cannons on both sides of a large vessel in the center. The sails of all seven ships are riddled with holes from cannon fire. Flags and pennants fly from their masts. Additional ships are faintly visible in the background.
