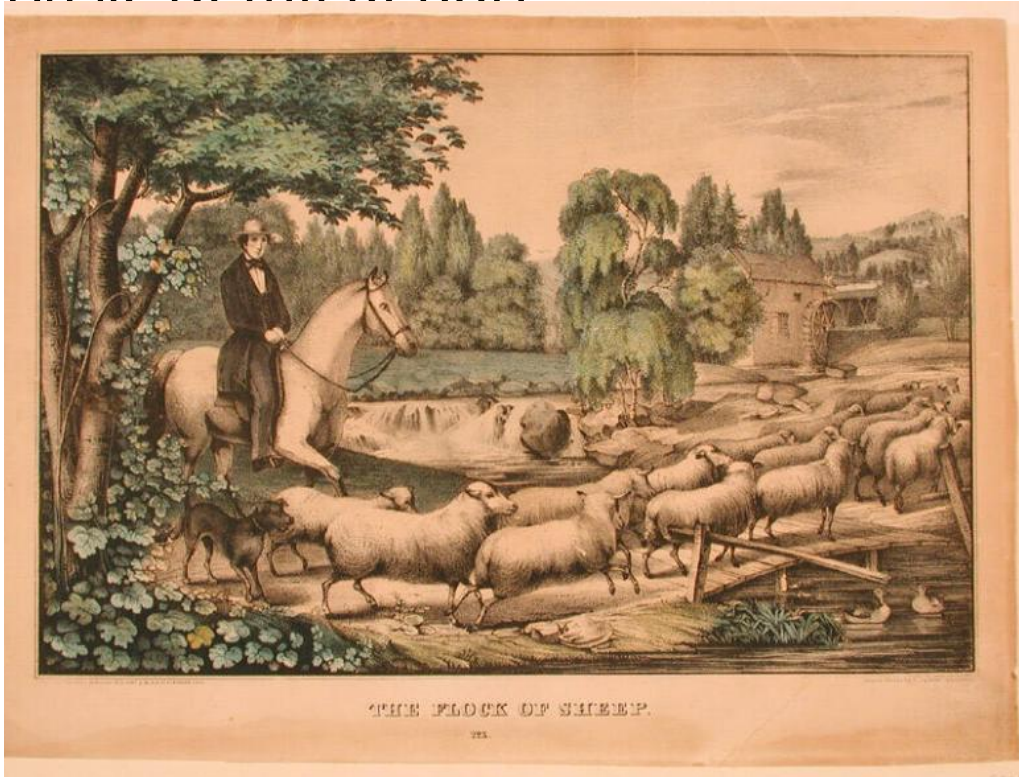


# Basic Detail Report



**Title** The Flock of Sheep.
