

Title Teapot

Medium Mechanically-molded black basalt

Description Round, plain, black basalt lidded teapot, with glaze applied to the inside only. The teapot (.a) swells from a relatively small base to a round lid (.b) with a small round finial. The teapot handle, most likely formed by extruding, is applied opposite the spout which was formed from two molded pieces.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height including lid x width x depth): $4\,1/2\,x\,5\,x$ $4\,3/4$ in. (11.4 x 12.7 x 12.1cm)
