

## Title Plate

Date about 1965-1970

Primary Maker Staffordshire potteries

Medium Mechanically-molded ironstone with underglaze cobalt blue decoration Description Round, white, ironstone plate with a transfer-printed underglaze cobalt blue pattern. The plate has a circular, flat foot and a deeply flaring rim.

The plate is decorated with scenes from Yale University, beginning with an image in the center of the plate, titled above "SOUVENIR OF YALE" and below "OLD BRICK ROW". This image shows a group of four-story buildings, one of which has a tower at one corner. The row of buildings is behind a group of

leafless trees growing in an area surrounded by a fence. This scene is surrounded by a narrow border of semi-circles and triangles on a dark blue field.
