## Title Plate

Date 1890-1896

Primary Maker Martial Redon & Co.

Medium Mold-formed hard paste porcelain with overglaze green enamel and gilding

Description Hard paste porcelain plate with overglaze green enamel and gilding.

The plate is round in shape, but with an uneven rim that imitates the edge of a shell or feather. The rim has been covered in a green enamel that follows the uneven shape of the plate. The green enamel is surrounded at the rim and at the inside edge of the enamel with hand-applied gilding. The center of the plate is

white and decorated with a delicate vine and leaf motif that emerges from the gilding and green enamel. Some of the vines are painted in a thin gilding, while other vines and flowers are applied with a thicker gilding on top. This gives the gilt motif a three-dimensional appearance. A smaller group of vines and flowers emerges on the opposite rim from the larger decoration described above.
