

## Title Mug

Date late 18th-early 19th century

Primary Maker Annis Pettibone

Medium Wheel-thrown cream-colored earthenware

Description Small, cylindrical mug of cream-colored earthenware with a clear glaze, a type of ceramic known as creamware. The mug is plain, with straight vertical sides and a flat bottom. A handle was pulled and applied to the mug. There is a hand-written label affixed to the side of the mug that reads, "Cup belonging to/ Grandmother Humphrey/ she died in 1819 aged 76".

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width including handle x depth): 2 15  $/16 \times 3 \frac{1}{2} \times 2 \frac{5}{8}$  in. (7.5 x 8.9 x 6.7cm)
