## Title Plate

Medium Mechanically-molded ironstone with underglaze cobalt blue decoration

Description Round, ironstone plate with underglaze cobalt blue transfer-printed borders and a pattern titled, "Soldiers Memorial Arch, Hartford, Conn." The circular pattern, printed in the center of the plate, shows a stone bridge with two round stone towers supporting an arch and a walkway from either side of the bridge. The arch and bridge are in a wooded setting, and there are power lines crossing the bridge. In the background, a circular dome rises above the trees.

The pattern is surrounded by a border at the rim, with various large flowers and leaves on a field of light blue. A narrow border at the outer edge of the rim consists of a scalloped white line and a series of blue circles creating a geometric pattern. There is crazing over all the surfaces of the plate.
