## **Title Rocky Mountain Ram**

Date 1930-1940s

Primary Maker Luman Pierre Kelsey

Medium Cast artificial stone

Description Sculpture made of solid tan "cast stone," an artificial stone material composed of lime and a polyester binder, that was cast in a mold. The compact, abstract sculpture shows a pair of large, curving horns around the eyes and head

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of the sculpture, curving down into a neck and body with a short upturned tail.

Two appendages beneath the body of the sculpture represent feet and legs. The

letter "K" is incised into the bottom of the sculpture's front foot. The surface of

the sculpture is smooth, but pitted.
