Medium Pressed colorless lead glass

Description Thick, pressed colorless lead glass pitcher. The pitcher has a plain rim that swells forward and upward to form a spout, a concave neck, and vertical, slightly tapered sides. A solid, ear-shaped handle has been applied

opposite the spout, connecting the rim with the body of the pitcher. The lower half of the handle has four impressed, tooled, horizontal lines and a bottom that curls back onto itself. The sides are decorated with an all-over pattern of sharp, raised diamonds known as the "Sharp Diamond" or "Diamond Point" pattern. The pitcher is supported by an octagonal foot and rayed bottom around a central concave depression in the glass. There are several minor chips and scratches to the glass around the bottom edge of the foot, and on a minimum of the sharp diamond points. There are two spots of opaque white paint adhered to the pitcher, to the lower left of the spout.
