

## **Title Goblets**

Date 1845-1870

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Pressed colorless lead glass

## **Basic Detail Report**

Description Pair of pressed colorless lead glass goblets. Each goblet has a straight rim and sides, and a hexagonal stem that forms a knob close to the disc-shaped, flat-bottomed base. The sides of each goblet are pressed with a pattern known as the Ashburton pattern. This consists of a series of loops of flutes circling the bottom of the goblet, with an offset oval above. Each goblet has light scratches at the rim and in a ring around the bottom. Goblets 1., .3-.4, and .6-.7 deaccessioned in 2006.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x diameter of each goblet):  $6 \times 3 \times 3/8$  in. (15.2 x 8.6cm)
