Title Sugar Bowl

Medium Sheet pewter

Description Pewter sugar bowl, part of a coffee service consisting of a coffeepot, creamer, and sugar bowl. Each object in the set is hexagonal, with straight sides that taper from bottom to top. Each has at least one solid, angular handle that is soldered to the body. Each is formed from a sheet of pewter that is beaten to the appropriate shape; one angled corner of each object is a soldered seam. The

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bottom is also formed from a pewter sheet that is soldered to the body. The

sugar bowl has two handles, one each on opposite sides of the body. The body

of the sugar bowl has minor scratches.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width with handles x depth): $2 \frac{3}{4} \times 4$
