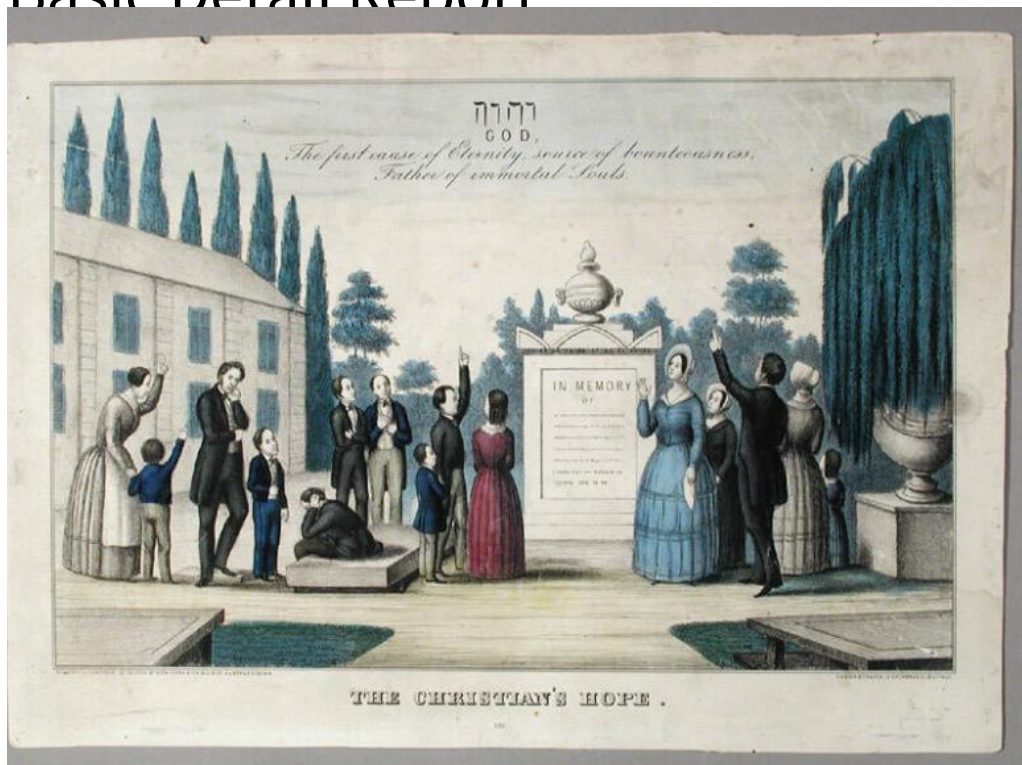

source of bounteousness, / Father of immortal Souls." A weeping willow is at the far right, near a large urn. Other trees in the background probably include cedars or poplars.
