

# Basic Detail Report

## **Title House for W. S. Griswold, Steele Road, West Hartford**

Date 1921

Description Plans for a two-story brick house with an attic and a cellar. The house has two chimneys and a shingled roof. It includes two porches, one on the front side of the house (adorned with four columns) and a smaller porch with latticwork extending off the kitchen on the west side of the house. The south side of the house features three large glass doors. The floor plans for the basement include a garage with a concrete floor, and also heater, coal, and laundry rooms. The first floor has a sun parlor, living room and dining room (with glass doors), a hall, toilet, den, butler's pantry, and a kitchen. On the second floor there are three chambers (bedrooms), one of which is labeled "own chamber." There is also a sleeping porch, a hall, and two baths. The attic plans show a storage area, a maid's chamber, and a bath.
