## Title Lock at Entrance to Enfield Canal, Windsor Locks

Date late 19th-early 20th century

Description Frame buildings are located on a strip of land between the Connecticut River and the Enfield Canal. Men stand on the bank overlooking the river. A wooden lock is below the buildings. A pile of lumber is on a sandy bank in the foreground. A rail fence is in the background. Large houses are on the opposite shore of the river.
