Description Two side-by-side maps of the night sky, with stars of varying sizes,
including clusters and nebulas, and depictions of the constellations. The map on
the left side shows the constellations in the September, August and July sky,
with the solstitial and equinoctial colures, and line of the earth's orbit. The map
on the right shows the constellations in the June, May and April sky, with two
equinoctial colures and the line of the earth's orbit. Only some of the
constellations are colored; the significance of this is unknown.
