

Roads indicated include "The Old Connecticut Path," "The Providence Road," "The Greenwood Path," and the "Nipmunk Path." Other areas identified include the Wabbaquassett Country, Quinebaug Country, Nipmunk Country, the Whetstone Country, and Mohegan Land, as well as Mamasqueeg, Joshua's Tract, New Besatuck, New Scituate, Stoddard's Tract, Canada Parrish, Roxbury Parrish, and Blackwell's Tract. Rivers, including the Willimantic and Shetucket Rivers, ponds, lakes, and hills are also shown. Elevation is indicated by hachure marks.
