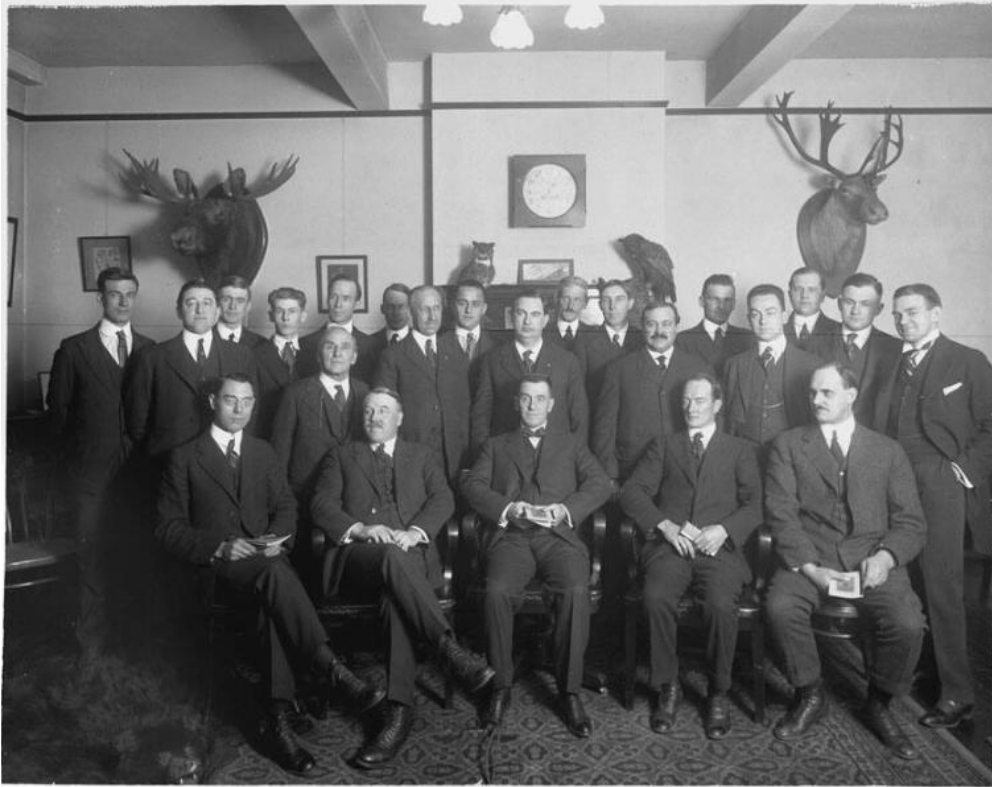

Description A group of twenty-three men, all in business suits and neckties, pose inside a room with multiple hunting trophies positioned around the room.
