Description View looking down the glen at Cotton Hollow, also known as Cotton Factory Village. Roaring Brook flows steeply downhill with trees on either side, inscribed "Button wood / interspersed / with / Hemlock" on the left and "Hemlock" on the right. Houses and other buildings line the stream on the left; large industrial buildings are in the background. Barber, in his text, identifies the business as the Hartford Manufacturing Co
