

# Basic Detail Report

**Title** Collingsville, (Canton)

**Date** 1834

**Medium** Drawing; pencil on paper

**Description** View of Collingsville from the West Side of the Farmington River. The large buildings of the Collingsville Ax factory are in the center of the composition, on the far side of the river. The houses of the workmen are in the foreground. A figure, probably a self-portrait of the artist sketching, is seated on a large rock. Trees at the right are labeled "pines." A note refers to "a hill which ascend with considerable abruptness from the water."<br>
