## **Title Lower Mystic.**

Description View of Portersville and the Mystic River. The river is the boundary line between Groton and Stonington and is transversed by the Mystic Bridge.

Several tall ships are in view. A windmill is at the right. A "Tavern" and the

Mariner's Church ("M. Church") are marked. "Candle wood hill" and "Lantern

Hill" are also labeled to the right. Although a note refers to the "Mystic Bridge"

(which Barber in his text describes as a toll bridge), the bridge itself is not clearly visible.
