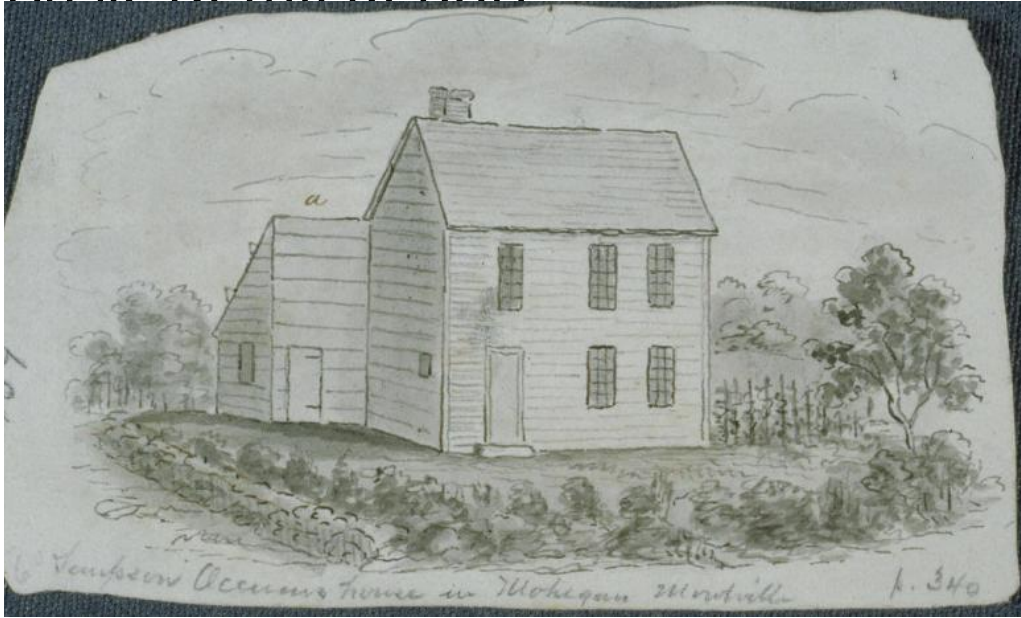


# Basic Detail Report



**Title** Sampson Occum's house in Mohegan, Montville.

**Date** probably 1836

**Primary Maker** John Warner Barber

**Medium** Drawing; ink on paper

**Description** Small two-story frame house with an addition at the left that is said by Barber to have been used by Sampson Occum as a study. A stone wall is on the left and a cornfield is to the right of the house.

**Dimensions** Primary Dimensions (overall height x width): 2 3/8 x 3 15/16in. (6 x 10cm)
