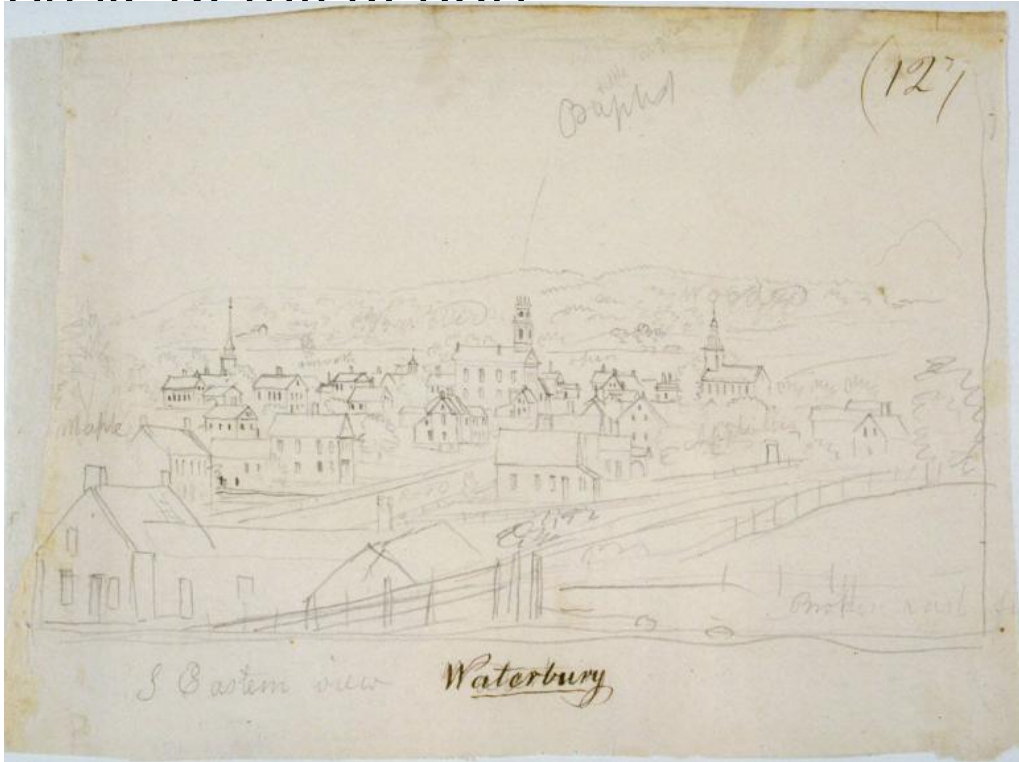


# Basic Detail Report
