

## Title Plan of Riverfront at Hartford, Ct. showing proposed new dock line between Gas Dock and Colt's Dock

Description Plan shows a section of the Hartford waterfront near the confluence of the Park River with the Connecticut River. The line of the Valley Division of the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad, with a bridge across the Park River, and the property of the Hartford and New York Transportation Company, the so-called Gas Dock, are shown. Also shown are Colt's Dock, a "dock for unloading stone," the proposed Hartford Electric Light Company Dock, and the Dutch Point power station of the Hartford Electric Light Company.
