

## Title Steamer City of Lawrence docked in Norwich

Date about 1890

Description Steamer docked at the head of the Thames River in Norwich, at the junction of the Yantic and the Shetucket. A sign on the bow reads: "Norwich Line via New London." The excursion steamer Ella is near the bow of the other ship.

In front of the ship is a schooner-rigged steam yacht. A coal barge is at a large dock at the left, with a catboat or cat-rigged sailboat in front of it. The shore in the background is lined with houses and industrial buildings.
